



PRINTING GUIDELINES

It is our aim to provide you with high quality designs for you to print at your convenience.

The quality of the print is dependant upon the quality of your printer, ink cartridges and paper material. The output might look significantly different from a color inkjet printer, versus a color laser printer for example. The weight and texture of paper will also significantly impact the final print.

The photographs of our products on our website are done on standard office supply papers and cardstocks, easily and inexpensively available at local stores in the United States, using color laser printers. We recommend that you take time to adjust the settings on your printer so that the page margins are minimal.


Our designs are produced to provide the maximum number of images possible on a single page. Our designs all have a set border of .25 (1/4) inches or approximately 7 mm all around a standard 8.5 x 11 format. We suggest you may want to print this guideline page until your margins and print quality are to your satisfaction in order to minimize ink usage. So that you may preview your ink and paper outputs, we include this sheet with color swatches for your reference.

It is our pleasure to provide these handwriting guideline pages for you in different scales in service to the critical history of script etched by the human hand. It is as important to be able to read old family recipes as it is to read historical documents in politics, literature, culture, legal, medical, scientific, religious, philosophical and anthropological fields to name a few.

We encourage you to spread these for distribution to aid in the endurance of the art of writing.
